III. NEW BUSINESS

- A. **PILOT Affidavits** Karen Niday reported to the board that all affidavits have been received and reviewed. Only one business is not incompliance and counsel will be contacting the proper taxing authorities.
- B. **Byrne Dairy** Garry VanGorder introduced Jim Gosier, General Counsel for Byrne Dairy to the board. Mr. Gosier reported that the company has successfully completed the vast majority of the operations considered in the PILOT agreement. The plant has been producing yoghurt, sour cream and other cultured products for almost 18 months. The cheese portion of the project has not been completed nor does the company plan to proceed with making cheese at this facility. Although there is a new product they will be introducing in 2017, which he was not at liberty to reveal at this time.

He reported that a part of the Agritoursim center has been completed, but the balance of the construction is still being assessed. The company has exceeded the \$20 million dollar investment and have exceeded the employment goals as agreed upon in the PILOT Agreement. He expressed how happy the company is to be here and are happy with the employment force they have in place.
